

THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me WILLIAM JOHN BARTLETT  
of Goulburn in the State of New South Wales Retired Brewer  
I APPOINT EDWARD FRANCIS THOMAS of Goulburn Solicitor FRANCIS HOWARD  
CARMAN of Goulburn Local Manager for Tooth & Co.Ltd. and WILLIAM  
HENRY WILLIAMS of Goulburn Produce Merchant (hereinafter called my  
Trustees) Executors and Trustees of this my Will and I declare that  
all trusts powers authorities and discretions hereinafter vested in  
my Trustees may be exercised by the survivors or survivor of them  
or other the trustees or trustee of this my Will and I give to my  
Trustees as named and mentioned as aforesaid each the sum of One  
thousand three hundred and thirty three pounds six shillings and  
eightpence (£1333.6.8) for their trouble in acting as such Executors  
and Trustees up to the time of the distribution of the charitable and  
pecuniary legacies in this my Will set out and specified and there-  
after they shall be allowed such commission or sums as is usual and  
as allowed by the Judge or Registrar having Jurisdiction in the  
passing of accounts in the Probate Jurisdiction of The Supreme Court  
of New South Wales I DIRECT that my Trustees shall use primarily all  
moneys I may leave either at any Bank or current account or fixed  
deposit or at call at such Bank or elsewhere or any other moneys  
whatever for the payment of my just debts funeral and testamentary  
expenses and if this is not sufficient my Trustees shall apply and if  
necessary for this purpose convert such Commonwealth or State Stock  
bonds treasury notes or scrip as may be necessary to provide any  
balance therefor I DIRECT that immediately upon my death my Trustees  
shall make all necessary arrangements for having my body cremated  
and arrange for any funeral for me without any undue ostentation or  
ceremony and that my remains be sent to the Crematorium in Sydney or  
elsewhere and the ashes of my said body shall be buried under the  
oak tree in the centre of the large lawn at "Broughton" my home in  
Goulburn aforesaid and a suitable tablet erected on or at such tree  
bearing a suitable inscription to locate such ashes of my remains  
I GIVE the hereditaments known as "Broughton" at Goulburn and all  
messuages erected on same and all lands held therewith and constitut-  
ing my residence and appurtenances and all furniture effects and other  
goods chattels and effects whatsoever on or about the same at the

time of my death (other than money and securities for money or evidencing any debts due to me or my books of account or other books or memoranda showing my affairs which are necessary for the information and guidance of my Trustees in the due administration of my estate and which are to be held by my Trustees until the final winding up) unto my Trustees UPON TRUST to permit HUBERT DUDLEY TAYLOR of Gundary Dairymen and Farmer and ELIZABETH TAYLOR his wife to use and enjoy the same during their lives or during the life or the survivor of them they respectively keeping the same in good repair and preservation reasonable wear and tear excepted and also insured against fire and also during such occupancy or occupancies paying all rates taxes charges and assessments on same and after the deaths of them the said Hubert Dudley Taylor and Elizabeth Taylor and the survivor of them UPON TRUST for all the children of them the said Hubert Dudley Taylor and Elizabeth Taylor in equal shares absolutely as tenants in common AND I DIRECT my Trustees to have made in duplicate an inventory of the goods chattels and effects included in the foregoing bequest one copy whereof shall be signed by my Trustees and delivered to the said Hubert Dudley Taylor and Elizabeth Taylor or one of them and another copy shall be signed by the said Hubert Dudley Taylor and Elizabeth Taylor and retained by my Trustees AND I declare that my Trustees shall not be bound during the lives of the said Hubert Dudley Taylor and Elizabeth Taylor to see to the preservation of the said hereditaments and goods chattels and effects nor be answerable for any loss or injury which may happen thereto from any cause whatsoever I DIRECT my Trustees to transfer to the proper officers or person or persons authorised to receive same for or on behalf of The William Thompson Mason Hostel and School at Baulkham Hills the Mortgage which I hold from Stephen Herford of Sydney Solicitor for the sum of Four thousand pounds (£4000) such Mortgage and the proceeds derived from same together with all interest and other emoluments on same from the date of such transfer to be devoted to such purposes and to and for such ends intents and purposes as the council or proper authority of such School or Hostel shall think fit I DIRECT my Trustees to invest the sum of Two thousand pounds (£2000) in any investments as Trustees are authorised to invest in New South Wales with power to

vary such investments from time to time and to pay the income of such investments to the Committee of The Goulburn and District Hospital or the person entitled to receive same for such Hospital and be used and devoted to such purposes for such Hospital as the said Committee of such institution shall think fit or my said Trustees may if they think fit as soon as practicable after my death pay such sum of Two Thousand Pounds (£2000) to such person or Committee for such purposes of the said Hospital as such person or committee think fit I DIRECT my Trustees to invest the sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) in such investments as Trustees are authorised to invest in New South Wales with power to vary the investments thereof and to pay the income thereof to the governing body or committee of management or treasurer of the Goulburn and District Ambulance for the purpose of such Ambulance and as such governing body or committee of management thinks fit Provided that my Trustees may as soon as practicable after my death if they think fit hand the said sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) to the said governing body committee or treasurer of The Goulburn and District Ambulance and be used for such purposes of the said Ambulance as such governing body or committee thinks fit I GIVE the sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) to The Mother Superior of the Committee or person or persons entitled to receive same for and behalf of St. John of God's Hospital at Goulburn and be devoted by such Mother Superior or Committee or person or persons entitled to receive same to such purposes of the said Hospital as it she or they shall think fit I GIVE the following legacies namely to the Trustees of the Dr. Barnardo National Incorporation Association or other the persons entitled to receive the same in New South Wales the sum of Two Hundred Pounds (£200) for the relief welfare keep control management and advancement of such children as come under the control of such association or persons in New South Wales and also a further sum of Two Hundred Pounds (£200) to the Treasurer of the said Dr. Barnardo Homes National Incorporation Association at Numbers Eighteen to Twenty six Stepney Causeways London England or wherever else such Association may be in England for the relief welfare keep control management and advancement of the children as come under the authority or control of that association in England

or elsewhere other than in New South Wales I DIRECT my Trustees to invest the sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) in such investments as aforesaid with the like power to vary the same as aforesaid and apply the income derived from such investments towards the improvement beautification and upkeep (other than lighting the same) of the Goulburn War Memorial and road and park appertaining to same as the Goulburn Municipal Council may think fit or my said Trustees may if they think fit give to the said Municipal Council the said sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) to be used for such purposes in connection with or incidental to the said War Memorial as it thinks fit I GIVE to the Trustees of the Goulburn and District Sub-Branch of the Returned Sailors Imperial League of Australia or other the persons entitled to receive the same the sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) to be applied for the relief keep or assistance of returned soldiers and sailors of that sub-branch or their dependents as the said Trustees or other persons entitled to receive the same or the committee of management of such Sub-branch may think fit I GIVE to the aforesaid Hubert Dudley Taylor the sum of One thousand pounds (£1000) and also to the aforesaid Elizabeth Taylor the sum of One thousand pounds (£1000) I GIVE to Lindsay Gordon Taylor and Dudley Hubert Taylor the sons of the said Hubert Dudley Taylor and Elizabeth Taylor the sum of Five hundred pounds (£500) each I GIVE to Nancy Maude Robson of "Ingleburn" Angelo Street Burwood and to Mary Lester Robson of the same place the sum of One thousand pounds each (£1000) I GIVE AND DEVISE to the nephew of my late wife Norman Bartlett Taylor the property known as "The Bridge Hostel" and the cottage adjoining the same which property and cottage are situate in Goldsmith Street Goulburn also my property in Grafton Street Goulburn known as "The Builders Arms" and also any money (if any) held by me in trust for him in the Commonwealth Savings Bank at Goulburn I ALSO EMPOWER my said Trustees if they can do so after payment of the various bequests and legacies hereinbefore mentioned and without causing the sale of my real estate and should they think fit either to invest the sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) as aforesaid and apply the income thereof to the further educational assistance of any scholar or scholars as after my death may pass with

distinction the Leaving Examination as they think fit or if they so desire as the Headmaster for the time of the Goulburn High School may think fit or my Trustees may give if and when they think fit such sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) to the Headmaster of the said Goulburn High School to be applied in the best manner for the purposes aforesaid and as my Trustees and the Headmaster may think fit I DECLARE that my Trustees may and if they think fit so to do I hereby so authorise them to appropriate and transfer any mortgages or securities or investments or stock on bond I may hold at the time of my death in satisfaction or part satisfaction of any legacy or legacies as aforesaid and all such mortgages or securities or investments or stock or bonds shall be calculated and applied by my Trustees and taken and accepted by such legatees respectively in satisfaction of such legacy or legacies either on the face value of same or if my Trustees think fit either by realisation of same and payment out of same to such respective legatees AND I further declare that with regard to the charitable or other bequests to any institution or body or corporation the receipt of the treasurer of the respective institution body or corporation in whose favor I have made such bequests shall be a good and valid discharge to my Trustees of the same I FURTHER DECLARE that my Trustees shall have full power to determine whether any money forming part of my estate ought to be considered as capital or income for the purpose of this my Will and out of what part and whether any expenses or outgoings ought and will be paid out of capital or income and my apportion blended trust funds and determine every and other question arising in or about the execution of trusts or powers herein contained and the determination of my Trustees on any question as aforesaid shall be conclusive and binding on all parties interested AND I DECLARE that the Executors and Trustees for the time being of this my Will may instead of acting personally employ any Solicitor Accountant or other agent to transact any business or do any act to be done in connection with the administration of my estate or trusts hereby declared including the payment of money and they shall be entitled to be allowed and paid all charges and expenses properly chargeable therefor and my said Executors and Trustees shall not be responsible for the default of any such Solicitor, accountant or

agent of for any loss occasioned by his or their employment  
AND FURTHER that my Trustee Edward Francis Thomas or his firm  
whether he shall accept the trusteeship or not shall be the  
Solicitor to my Trust property and estate and as such notwithstanding  
his acceptance of the trusteeship he or his firm allowed in  
addition to the legacy left to him as aforesaid be allowed all  
professional and other charges for his or their time and trouble  
which if employed as solicitor or solicitors to my Trustees he or  
they if employed as solicitor or solicitors to my Trustees the said  
Edward Francis Thomas not being himself a Trustee he or they will  
be entitled to make AS to my real property situated in Clinton and  
Sloane Streets Goulburn aforesaid and consisting of the Southern  
Railway Hotel and the weatherboard cottage adjoining previously  
occupied by Ah Chong and the terrace houses formerly part of  
Mandelshon's Terrace in Sloane Street Goulburn aforesaid and also  
the property now occupied by James McIntyre and formerly known as  
Stewart's I GIVE the same to my Trustees UPON TRUST to continue  
to receive the rents and profits thereof and also to further let  
or lease the same or any part thereof UPON such terms and condit-  
ions as my Trustees think fit for any periods as to any of such prop-  
erty up to ten years from the date when the sublease of the said  
Southern Railway Hotel shall fall due and during such periods  
of ten years my Trustees shall receive the rents and profits and  
place same to a special account out of which all rates repairs  
maintenance and insurance on all such property shall be paid and any  
balance shall form part of my residuary estate and be divided at  
such times as may be thought practicable or convenient by my Trust-  
ees amongst the persons who take the residuary estate as herein-  
after mentioned PROVIDED that as regards the terrace property and  
the weatherboard cottage in Sloane Street Goulburn aforesaid my  
Trustees may if they think fit sell the same or any part thereof  
for cash or on terms and invest the proceeds as aforesaid with  
power to vary same as aforesaid and the income of such investments  
shall be paid to my residuary devisees as if same were any balance  
of rents and profits as aforesaid at the expiration of the said  
ten years as aforesaid I direct my Trustees to sell and convert  
into money the said properties in Sloane and Clinton Street

Goulburn aforesaid either privately or by public auction or for cash or on such terms as they think fit and divide the nett proceeds thereof in equal shares amongst the said Hubert Dudley Taylor Elizabeth Taylor, Mary Lester Robson and Nancy Maude Robson who are hereby called my residuary devisees I DIRECT my Trustees to discharge the mortgage and any further charges thereon which I may hold from Loris Ingamells and Amy Barnes at the time of my death free of all principal moneys and interest due from the date of such transfer or discharge and to reconvey or discharge the same to them or as they may direct but at their own cost and expense ALL the rest and residue of my property both real and personal I GIVE to my Trustees UPON TRUST to convert the same into money as they think fit and to divide the same with any money equally between my aforesaid residuary devisees I EMPOWER my Trustees to postpone the conversion of any part of my property for so long as they think fit and the income of any property remaining unconverted shall from the time of my death be paid and applied in the same manner as if it were income of investments of the proceeds of the conversion thereof I REVOKE all former Wills and Codicils and testamentary dispositions by me heretofore made AND I DECLARE that if any respective legatee or devisee under this my Will die before me and any issue of his or her be living at my death the gift of the legacy or devise shall not lapse but in that event I GIVE the said respective legacy or devise to his or her personal representative to be disposed of as part of his or her personal estate IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand this Third day of April One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.
