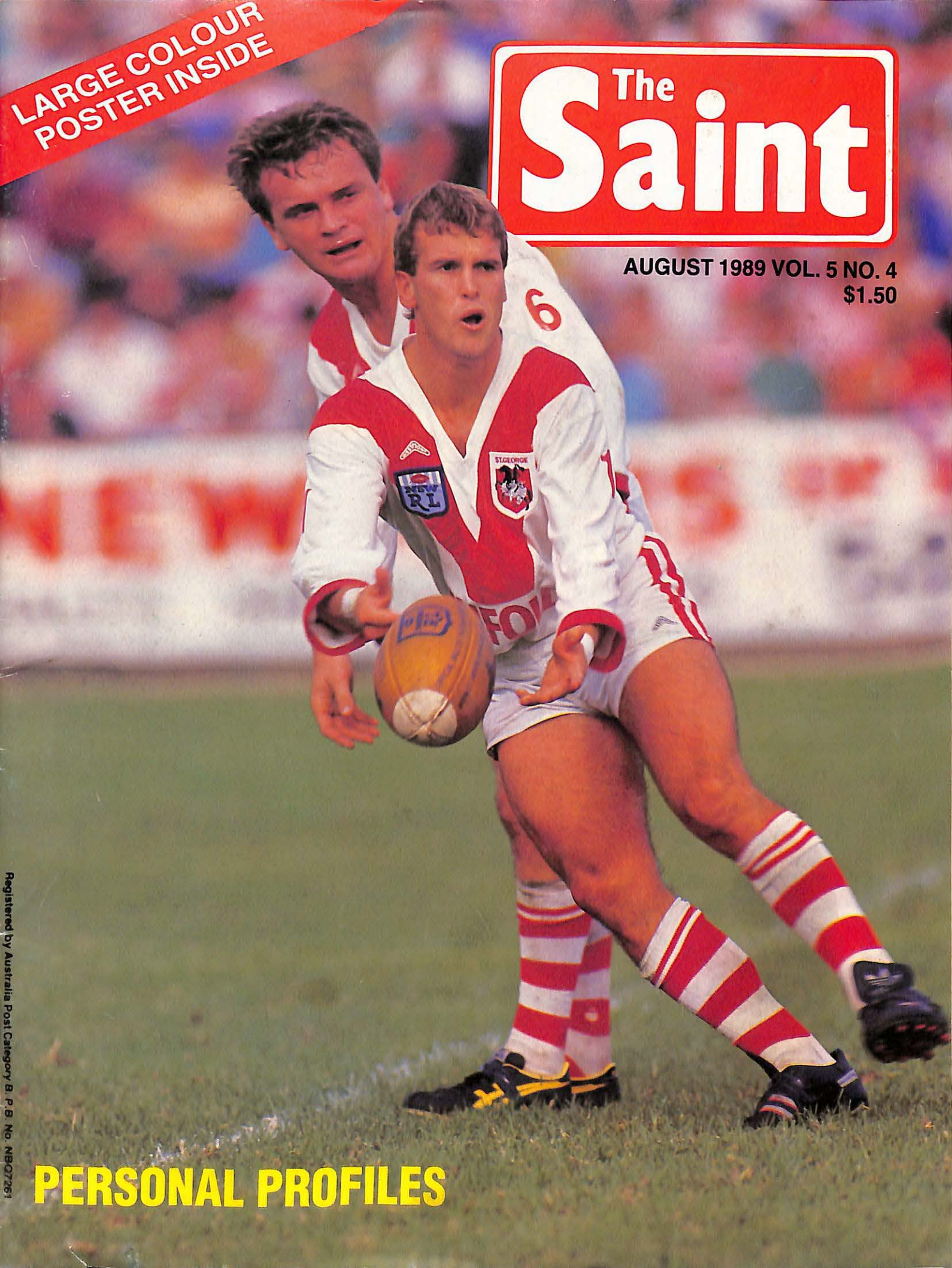

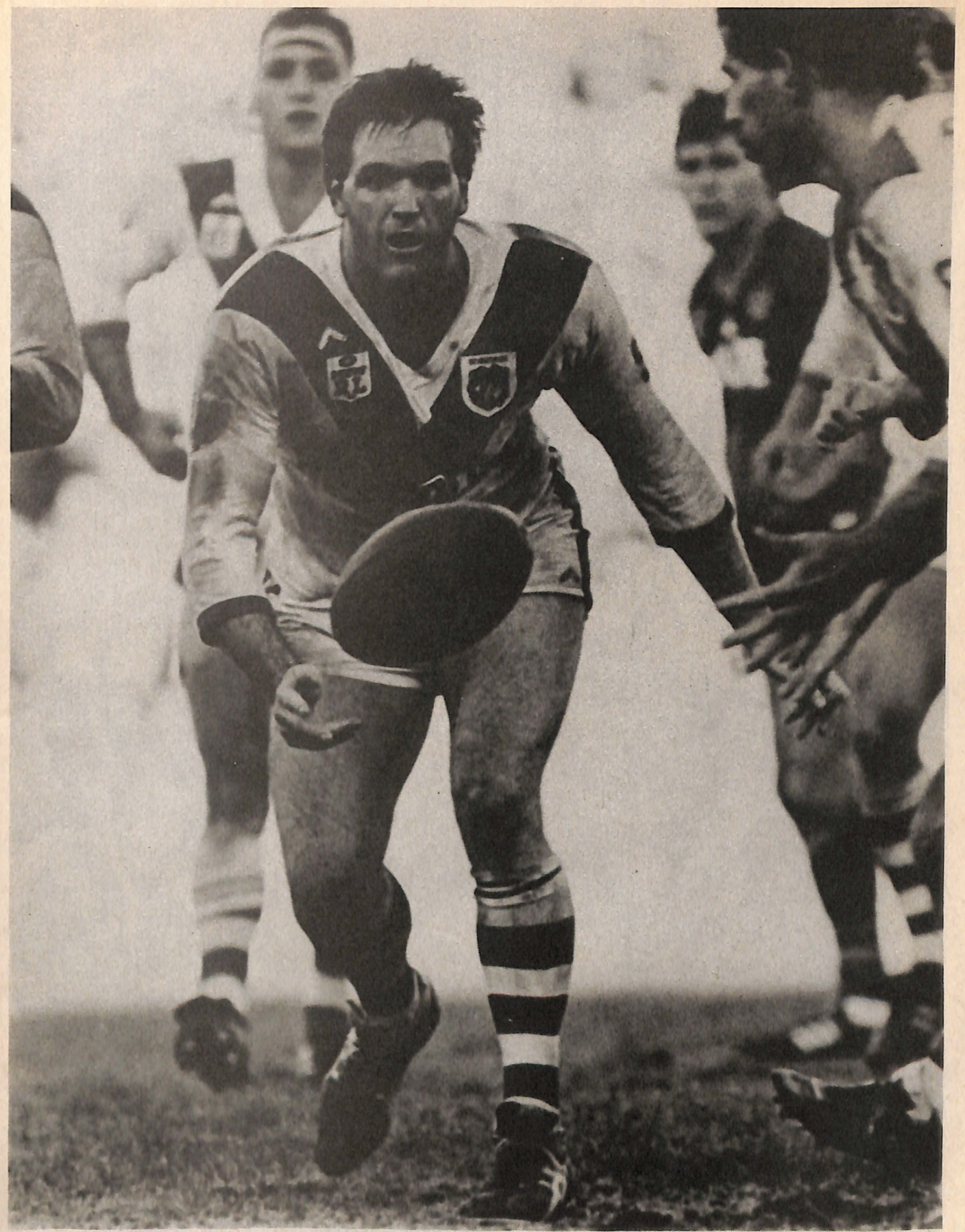

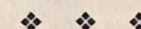
RICKY WALFORD is staking his claim as the leagues top pointscorer. At last count he was 4 points off the lead, holding onto second place.

Tom Berry's President Cup side must be close to setting a record for the number of drawn games they've played this season. To date they've scored 4!



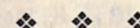

Junior League Report

The St. George Junior League Semi-Finals will be held on the 19th and 20th August with the Grand Finals on the 2nd and 3rd September.

At this stage 5 teams are vying for Semi-Final spots in the A grade and it is one of the closest competitions in recent years.

Undefeated teams currently are Arncliffe Scots (under 7), Peakhurst (under 8), Scots (under 12), and Brighton (under 14 and under 16).

The Presentation Night for the Junior Representative Teams is Friday 8th September at Peakhurst Bowling Club and tickets can be purchased from Gordon Lowrie by ringing 59 6315.

ARNCLIFFE SCOTS

Scots are travelling very well in most grades. To date we have a lead of ten points in the Junior Club Championship over Peakhurst and Hurstville. This is for grades U/7 to U/15 years.

In the Senior Club Championship for grades U/16 years to A grade Penhurst R.S.L. have a commanding lead followed by Scots and Brighton.

Scots U/7 and U/12 years teams are still undefeated. Our U/10 years team is on top of their competitions whilst our U/9 and U/11s are in third place.

The U/8s had their first win recently which will give them some confidence for future matches.

The U/15s have had one loss and have dropped back to fourth place with a postponed match to play.

The U/14s have won their last two games after a slow start, which covers all our junior teams.

In the Senior grades, the A Grade who have lost three players through suspension have no chance of making the Semi-Finals.

Our U/23 years team, who play in the Cronulla-Sutherland Competi-

tion, are in equal second place in a very closely contested competition.

The U/19 years team are combined with Balmain and are currently in fourth place. They can't afford to lose any more matches otherwise they will drop out of the four. Also combined with Balmain are our U/16s who are currently in third place behind Brighton and Glebe Police Boys.

Out of our twelve teams Scots hope to have nine teams in the Semi-Finals.

After the big wet it is hoped we can get some dry weather until September, Grand-Final Day.
