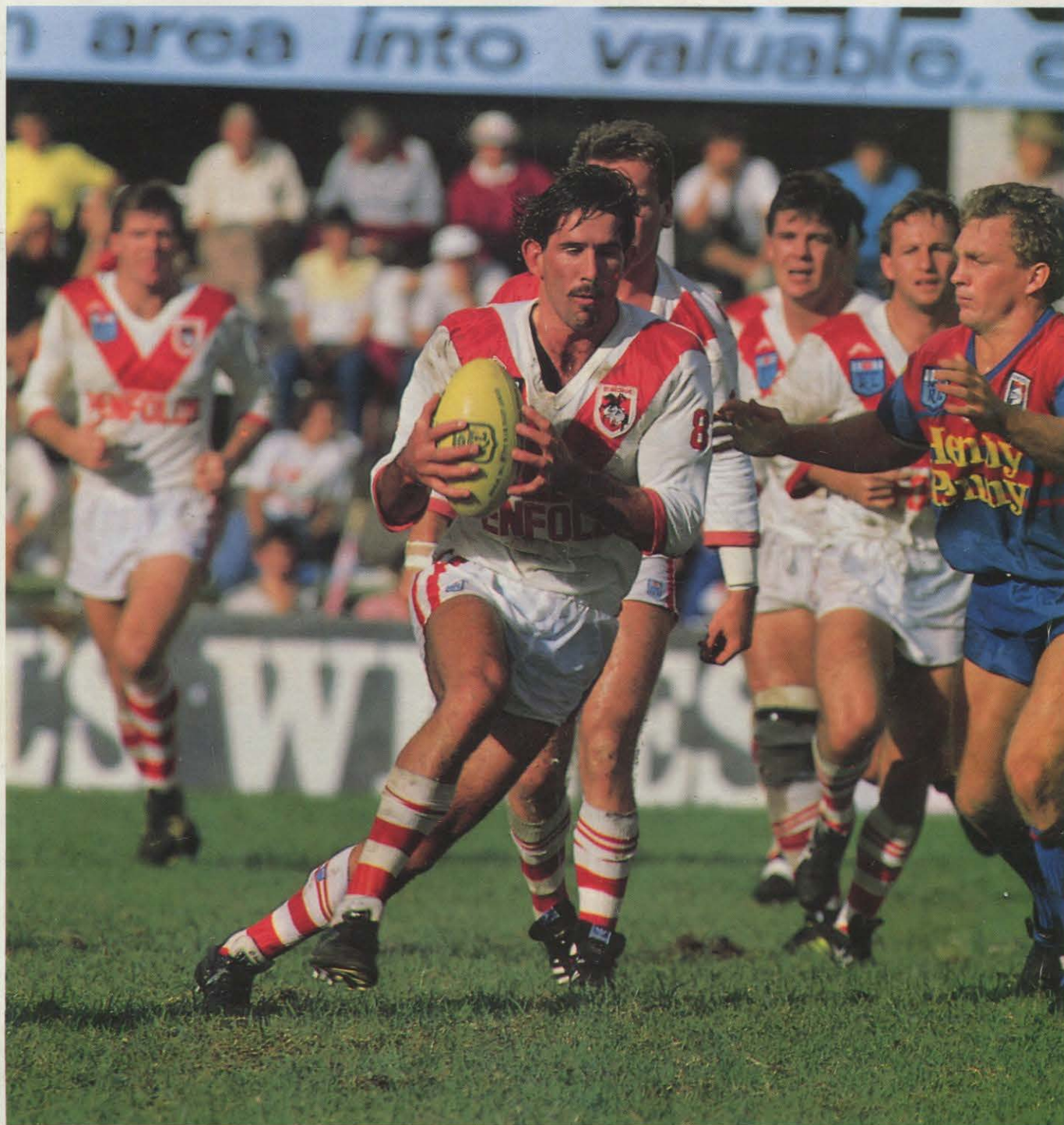

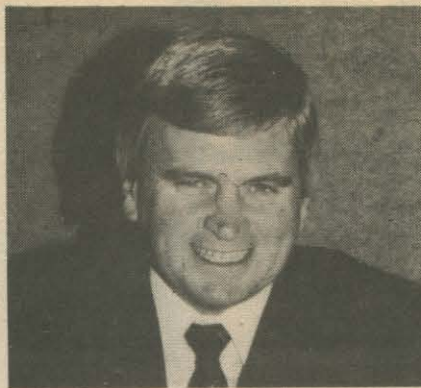
At the end of the 1988 season we received the resignation of our long time Secretary, John Fleming, after a reign of eleven years. John's association with the Club goes back over 20 years and he succeeded Frank Facer as Secretary in 1977 after an involvement with the Football Club Committee since 1968. COACHING AND DEVELOPMENT

1988, our Bicentennial year and my first full year as Development Officer at St. George.

The highlights would have to be the co-operation and friendliness shown to me by Leagues Club and Football Club staff. I don't believe I would find it at such a level in any other work place.

I would like to express my appreciation to all the Junior League Clubs for their support during the year and also the Junior League Executive. We have had our minor differences of opinion on occasion, however I would hope that a mutual respect remains for each other as our ultimate goal of providing quality football and quality coaching in a safe environment for the boys in our district is the same.

Many of our clubs are suffering the disease of the eighties which is not so much lack of finance but lack of interest or personnel. There are plenty of kids out there, however we have no adults prepared to devote some time to taking care of them. If you are a Rugby League person please think about working with a Junior Club in your area not necessarily as a coach, maybe a manager, first aid person or administrator. You may think you don't have the expertise to become involved, however there are plenty of very easy courses mainly of 12 hours duration that will qualify you to become a valuable asset to the Rugby League community.

Ladies, it may be a mans game and you may only think of yourselves as a Mum, a secretary, a cleaner or teacher but with all those skills behind you you're already half qualified to become involved in football.

I am very pleased to report that we had over 40 coaches obtain their Level One Coaching Certificates and 24 their Level Two over the last 12 month period and 4 of these coaches went on to obtain referees tickets as well.

I believe the high standard of play shown on Grand Final Day

by our junior teams reflects the manner in which caring, interested and qualified people are coaching them.

Our school development programme will be stepped up in the coming year particularly in the primary area, where our Coaching Panel will be seeking permission to show videos to P & C

meetings etc., in the hope of convincing parents of the safety and fitness aspect of our game.

On an administrative level the N.S.W.R.L. has this year made it a condition of entry into the Winfield Cup that each District form a Coaching and Development Policy Council

The function of this Council is to formulate a three year development programme to be implemented by myself, the Coaching Director and Coaching Panel. Details of the personnel on the Council for the St. George District will be published in the first edition of the Saint Magazine in 1989, as will the programme for the following 12 months coaching and development.

In closing I would like to thank the 1st and reserve grade players who made themselves available to do presentations and clinics, it was time well spent.

Most of all I would like to thank Mr John Fleming for his unceasing support and advice and on behalf of the Coaching Director Steven Hood and the members of the Coaching Panel we wish him well.

NEW COACH CRAIG KEEPS YOUNG...

Newly appointed first grade coach Craig Young has already started training the boys to get an early start for next year.

If keenness and dedication counts for anything (and I am sure it has a lot to do with it) then Saints are past the post at the top of the ladder.

With "Big Albert" in charge there will be no slackening off and the keenest is Craig himself.

He runs with the rest of the boys and offers himself as a measuring stick. Craig says anyone that can't beat him could find himself on the bench when the competition proper starts.

Young's record as a player can not be faulted, though at one stage he was nearly lost to soccer (what a great shame that would have been). Craig represented Australia in the

schoolboys side on a tour to England in 1972-73 a team coached by Roy Masters. In 1977 he joined Saints and has played with the red and whites ever since, twelve years in all. He played in 20 tests for Australia, won two competitions with Saints in 1977 and 1979, won a Panasonic Cup in 1988, so there is very little "Albert" has not done in his footballing career.

Therefore at the age of 32 he decided to give playing a miss. However he showed more than half an interest in coaching and managed to land the top coaching job with the club he loves best and has been loyal to for so many years.

Craig admits it was a hard decision to make but after playing over 230 games for the club, realistically it had to come

to an end. But Craig is not going to disappear from the scene. You will see his familiar large frame on the bench during matches and in the dressing rooms at half time and at the end of games, win or lose. He feels he has the players to lift Saints up off the ground and into a respectable position on the ladder in 1989.

He feels the players went well enough in 1988 but after their win in the Panasonic Cup there was a slackening of their standard which he puts down to inexperience in the younger players. But they are a year older and wiser with a lot of Sydney football under their belts.

St. George have done the right thing in picking Craig Young as head coach and another ex Saints player, John Dowling, as his reserve grade leader. The club has always done well with coaches that came from the players ranks in the past. To mind comes Ken Kearney, Sticks Provan, Ian Walsh and of late Harry Bath. This record is worth considering. Hoping "Big Albert" can emulate the old time greats.

Craig says things change constantly and one has to keep up with the times, henceforth a computer for statistics and a video player to show the mistakes occupy his office.

He refuses to be drawn into conversation about the comparison of the game of past and present.

He admits the game is faster than it was a decade or two ago but says training methods have also changed to make it easier on the players.

Craig you have always been an ornament to the game and one of its finest ambassadors so keep up the good work and we all wish you and all your players the best of luck and a successful 1989, which will be the beginning of a new era for St. George.

After three years playing away from our home ground Saints are ready for the big return to Kogarah.

The three years away in the wilderness have not exactly been successful and that has swayed the committee's decision to come home at last, even though the grand stand will not be completed until

next year, which means it will be in operation by the

start of the 1990 season. That is not that far away. . . time flies.

As you have read in the President's Report necessary adjustments are being made to the existing stand to make it acceptable to regulations and it will be safe to use.

Home ground advantage is an absolute must if the team is to feature in the top places

of the 1989 premiership.

Our chances in the 1989 season look extremely good with a new coach, some new players bought very strategically and back to permanent home turf. What can go wrong?

Judging by the enthusiasm of the new coach, Craig Young, and the players everything is ship shape

Though the facilities will be wanting comparison

to the Cricket Ground, if the team does well it will be worth putting up with for just eleven home games.

As we all know one of the most important factors in a club are the fans and therefore we ask you to come and support your team next year and make it a successful beginning to a new era.
